

Collaborations Map

The research information repository (or 'portal') shows a world map, with points representing research collaborations recorded in Pure.

The collaborations map appears at the University level (research.edgehill.ac.uk) but there is also one for each organisational unit and each person on the portal.



Inclusion criteria

For your collaborations to show on the map, the following criteria must be met:

- The map currently only shows collaborations on research output and project content.
- The date on the content record containing the collaboration must be in the last 5 years.
 - Research outputs: the date of any publication status e.g. accepted, published.
 - Projects: the life cycle start date.
- The content record's [visibility](#) should be set to public or campus only.
- Collaborations are with [external organisations](#), not just [external people](#).
 - Research outputs: the external organisation may be
 - an affiliation against a co-author, or
 - an standalone organisational affiliation not linked to an author.
 - Projects: the external organisation must be added in the collaborative partner section, not just indirectly affiliated through a co-investigator.

- The external organisation record in Pure needs to include the organisation's country.
 - o If the organisation already exists in Pure: let us know if the collaboration does not appear and we can check the country field is populated.
 - o If you need to create a new external organisation in Pure: you can add this information at the point of creation.
