## Online Submission and Assessment

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There are several tools found in the Learning Edge online learning environment, which can be used for online submission of assignments, and many other activities related to formative and summative assessment.

The table below gives you some introductory information about each, to help you in your decision-making.

By default all file types are accepted, but only files that meet certain criteria will result in the creation of Originality Reports. See the '<a href="#">File types and size</a>' help page for more information.</li> <li data-bbox="1045 613 1961 716">• Staff can view student submissions, along with Originality Reports that Turnitin creates for the submission.</li> <li data-bbox="1045 748 1808 786">• Grades are fed into Blackboard's Grade Centre.</li> <li data-bbox="1045 818 2024 920">• Email receipt of submission sent to students' university email address.</li>   <li data-bbox="1045 1024 2024 1127">• Students submit one or more files. Staff can view student submissions and provide feedback through the Grade Centre</li> <li data-bbox="1045 1159 2024 1333">• If the assignment has been set as 'Single attempt' and the student needs to resubmit, their previous attempt will need to be cleared in order to allow them to submit the correct file</li> </ul>

<p>On-line tests including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• multiple choice questions</li> <li>• multiple selection questions</li> <li>• hot spot questions</li> <li>• short answer questions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Blackboard's Tests, Pools, and Surveys Tool</a></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Various options are available that affect test presentation, feedback, grading, and number of attempts.</li> <li>• Some question types will require manual marking, while others could be automatically graded.</li> <li>• The timer records the time taken to complete the test rather than limits the time available to do it.</li> <li>• Question banks (i.e. Pools) can be created from which test questions can be randomly allocated.</li> <li>• Tests (and Pools) can be exported from one course and imported into another for re-use.</li> </ul>

This can feed grades into the Grade Centre.</p>
