The first item in your results list will be 'Taylor & Francis Journals', click on this.

You will see this screen. Click on 'Access Taylor & Francis Journals' and you will get to a login screen. Enter your Edge Hill username and password.





Your results will look like this:

The terms you searched for, and the number of articles matching your search is shown at the top. Around 30-40 is a manageable number.



You can search for articles by keyword, or author or DOI

Refine your search

You can refine your search using the left-hand column:

Subject

Click on a subject to see results in this area, or choose the + sign beside the subject to see further categories within it.

The subjects are ordered by size, starting with those containing the most articles. You can see the full list by clicking 'more'.

Published in

You can search one publication by clicking the box beside its title.

Publication date

Choose how far you want to go back – 1-12 months – or specify a date range.

Finally, click Add Filter to see your refined results.

The filters you have applied will show at the top of your results with your search terms highlighted in the title.



Click in a title to view the article.

You can read the abstract or the full article on screen, or choose PDF to download it.



Search Tips

Boolean operators

AND - results contain all of the terms entered

OR - results contain any one of the terms entered

NOT - results contain on term but do not contain another

Other tips

* – Use an asterisk (*) to match all terms beginning with a word root. Transplant* will match all terms beginning with the word transplant including but not limited to transplant, transplants, transplanting, transplantation, and transplantable. Your word root must contain at least three characters.

? – Use a question mark (?) to match a single character within a word. wom?n will match women or woman

"" – use quotes to find an exact phrase. Searching for "change management" will find articles where the whole phrase appears.
