Here we are at our weekly team meeting discussing the planning of virtual staff development and just catching up with developments and questions from all the academic departments.



eResources Tips

We have seen some excellent usage of the eResources, however if you have struggled at all to access full text or something doesn't' work quite right, here is some helpful guidance:

- Are you able to sign into your library account?
 If yes then your username and password are correct.
- Problems arise if you go direct to the website of a journal or database from a web search as you won't have the Edge Hill login that we build into URLs. Trying to find the right link to click for Institutional Access can be confusing and difficult and we don't recommend it.
- For journal articles use the Discover More link on www.edgehill.ac.uk/ls or in Blackboard in the library tab, to search for keywords. When you have done a search and are in Discover More, click the banner at the top of the screen to login to your Edge Hill account, this will make access much smoother as you will be authenticated once and will get direct access to the articles. Here is a screen shot:



- A good tip is to check your browser.
 Does the page behave in the same manner on a different web browser
 e.g. Firefox and Chrome?
- Also clear your Cache.

Accessibility and Ally – dedicated help with your content



Over the last year we've rolled out the use of <u>Blackboard Ally</u> to help identify accessibility issues with content and offer solutions.

The <u>Public Sector Bodies Accessibility Regulations</u>, will come into effect on 23 September 2018.

The legislation means that all electronic content on our websites and VLE must be accessible to all users. This includes all of your uploaded documents in Learning Edge. The good news is that huge progress has been made across the University.

We have recently contacted the named Module Leader with the aim to help you improve the accessibility of documents. Together we can make the necessary improvements to the content. At present during #Lockdown we also have a dedicated team who are available to collect and convert documents on your behalf.
