On arrival on campus you will have been given both an access card and a set of keys. To gain access to the building simply swipe the card over the box to the left/right side of the front door to give you access to the building. The key will let you into your corridor door and your bedroom door.

Fire Evacuation

What to do in an emergency...

Fire test calls take place every Thursday and should only last for a short time. Make sure you familiarise yourself with the fire procedures for the building which can be found on the back of your bedroom door.

If the fire alarm sounding is prolonged or it sounds on any other day than Thursday whilst you are in the accommodation make your way to the appropriate assembly point. A member of our Campus Support team will respond to all fire alarm alerts. Do not re-enter the building until a member of Campus Support has confirmed it is safe to do so.

To help us keep the risk of fire low, smoking is not permitted in any buildings nor is the lighting of candles and we ask all visitors to refrain from smoking in front of the entrance to buildings. Also, when using the kitchen facilities, please ensure all appliances are turned off after use.

The Campus Support Team is based in the Security and Customer Information Centre (Security) and is manned 24 hours day. The Campus Support team are all trained first aiders. The team can be reached by dialling 01695 584227 from a landline or mobile. Campus Support staff patrol the campus throughout the evening evening too.
