Introduction

Panopto's simple in-video quizzing capabilities help instructors test comprehension, reinforce key concepts, improve knowledge retention, and make videos more engaging. Instructors can create and add multiple choice, checkbox, and true/false questions to their recordings, directly from the video editor. Each quiz automatically pauses video playback, allowing viewers to take as much time as needed with each question.


Panopto quizzes can be connected to Blackboard's gradebook. The following steps explain how Panopto quizzes can appear in your Blackboard course as a column in the Grade Center.

Note, only Panopto videos with an existing quiz embedded using the Panopto video editor will intergrate fully in to the Grade Centre.


Integrating Panopto Quiz with Grade Centre

With the edit mode switched to 'ON', enter the Submission Dropbox menu link, and create a Panopto Quiz (tool) link.

- At the top of the Content page hover your cursor over the Build Content button.
- Locate and click the Panopto Quizzes tool.




- Enter a name for your quiz and add a description, the name will appear in the Grade Centre column.
- Choose the most appropriate settings for your needs. The Points Possible setting is required if you want the assignment grading. Usually this should be set to 100.


A screenshot of the configuration interface for a Panopto Quiz. It is divided into two main sections: 'GRADING' and 'OPTIONS'.

- Enter an appropriate Due Date
- You can limit students access to the Panopto Quiz link in the Options field, Select Date and Time Restrictions (default settings give students immediate access).
- Click Submit.

- A Panopto link will appear in the Content folder (Submission Dropbox), click on the Panopto quiz you have just created.



- Locate the video in your Panopto folder.
 - Only videos with an existing quiz will fully intergrate with the Grade Centre.



- Click on the radio button to the left of the video and click the Insert button that appears to the bottom right of the folder (this action generates a column in Grade Centre).
