

Collaborations Map

The research information repository (or 'portal') shows a world map, with points representing research collaborations recorded in Pure.

A collaborations map is available at every level on the portal from the entire University down to the individual person's profile. You can hide your own map through your <u>person profile settings</u>.



Criteria

For your collaborations to show on the map, the following criteria must be met:

- The map currently only shows collaborations on content types of:
 - o Research output.
 - o Project.
- The date on the content record containing the collaboration must be in the last 5 years.
 - o Research outputs: the date of any publication status e.g. accepted, published.
 - o Projects: the life cycle start date.
- The content record's <u>visibility</u> should be set to public or campus only.
 - o The visibility of individual files attached to a content record does not affect the collaborations map.
- Collaborations are with <u>external organisations</u> in the *Contributors & affiliations* (outputs) or *Participants* (projects) section of the record as either:

- o an affiliation against a co-author, or
- o a standalone organisational affiliation not linked to an author.
- The external organisation record in Pure needs to include the organisation's country.
 - o If the organisation already exists in Pure: let us know if the collaboration does not appear and we can check the country field is populated.
 - o If the organisation does not already exist in Pure, you can add this information when you create the external organisation record.
