Preparing for the future of work

Graduate success requires a combination of **both** hard and soft skills.

Soft skills

- time management
- teamwork
- creative thinking
- communication
- self-motivation
- problem solving
- positive attitude

Hard skills

- what have you learnt in your degree
- software and computing knowledge
- certifications

Five of the Most Popular Interview Questions

"Tell me about yourself."

Briefly talk about your background, your studies and about your career ambitions.

"Why should we give you the job?"

Talk about your experience and skills, your enthusiasm for the job and the relevant skills and qualities the employer is looking for.

"What are your strengths?"

Discuss your strengths that are suited for the role. For example, if you are being interviewed for a Marketing job, talk about your digital skills and any previous experience in which you played a key role and were successful.

"What are your weaknesses?"

Be positive and constructive. If you haven't got certain experience, say you are willing to learn and keen to develop your experience with them as an employer.

"Give an example of when you successfully worked in a team."

Discuss what team it was, what you did and how the team was successful.
