

## Call for Abstracts

As part of the first Conference of the Research Chair in Security and integrity in sport, we invite you to submit an abstract for an oral presentation related to violence in sport. The theme of this first conference is Safety and Integrity: For an Engaged Sport and Society. The duration of each oral presentation is 15 minutes. A 4-minute question period will follow each presentation (we reserve 1 minute for the transition between presentations). We would like you to use PowerPoint for your oral presentation. In doing so, you will be able to activate the live translation. The number of possible papers is limited to 60. Papers will be selected based on scientific quality.

You can submit an abstract in English or French. The language used for your abstract will indicate the language used for the presentation and will allow us to assign you to an appropriate room on the conference day.

### Guidelines for the abstract

We invite you to submit an abstract of 250 words maximum. In addition to your abstract, you must indicate the title (in capital letters), the author and co-authors. It is necessary to indicate the affiliations of the first author (i.e., the person presenting) and the co-authors.

You will receive news of abstracts acceptance by Friday, October 8, 2021. Registration for the conference will open on Tuesday, August 31. We remind you that participation in this conference is free of charge and that you do not have to make a presentation to attend!
