Getting to Campus...

By Road

Leave M6 at junction 26 and join M58.

Leave M58 at junction 3, taking the A570 towards Southport and Ormskirk.

You should see signs for 'Edge Hill University' when you leave the motorway. From junction 3 the journey is 2.8 miles and takes approximately 5 minutes. The campus can also be reached from Preston or Liverpool via the A59.

If using an online route planner or sat nav, please note that the university postcode is L39 4QP. Please check that the route provided arrives via the main entrance in St Helens Road. Alternatively enter lat/long co-ordinates 53.558622,-2.875178.

By Train

The nearest train station to Edge Hill University is Ormskirk train station. From Ormskirk station you can get to the campus in a variety of ways:

- Walk- Turn right from the station and walk up the road you are on, Station Approach. At the top turn left, then first right. Walk along Stanley Street and Knowsley Road, across two junctions, until you reach the main St Helens Road. Turn left and continue until you reach the Campus. This will take around 20 minutes.

The Catalyst. The £27 million Catalyst building, opened by Her Royal Highness, The Princess Royal, houses the University library and Careers and Student Services functions.

Trains **depart Ormskirk** at 04, 19, 34 and 49 minutes past the hour up until 19:49, the trains then run at 07 and 37 minutes past the hour until the last train at 23:37

Trains depart Liverpool Central at 01, 16, 31 and 46 minutes past the hour up until 19:46, the trains then run at 17 and 47 minutes past the hour until the last train at 23:47

A return ticket from Ormskirk to Liverpool costs approximately £8

Trains depart Ormskirk at 46 minutes past the hour up until 21:46, the last train departs at 23:10

Trains depart Preston at 10 minutes past the hour up until 21:10, the last train departs at 22:35

A return ticket from Ormskirk to Preston costs approximately £8

Getting to Manchester...

By Train:

The nearest train station to Edge Hill University is Ormskirk train station. From this station you can travel to Manchester a number of ways:

Option 1- Via Preston (approximately 1.5 hours):

Trains **depart Ormskirk to Preston** at 46 minutes past the hour up until 21:46, the last train departs at 23:10 Trains **depart Preston to Manchester** approximately every 15 mins. The last train departs at 23:49 Trains **depart Manchester to Preston** approximately every 15 mins. The last train departs at 21:02 Trains **depart Preston to Ormskirk** at 10 minutes past the hour up until 21:10, the last train departs at 22:35

A return ticket from Ormskirk-Preston-Manchester costs approximately £15.

Option 2- Via Liverpool (approximately 2 hours):

Trains **depart Ormskirk to Liverpool Central** at 04, 19, 34 and 49 minutes past the hour up until 19:49, the trains then run at 07 and 37 minutes past the hour until the last train at 23:37. You will need to walk to Liverpool Lime St Station which takes approximately 10 minutes.

Trains depart Liverpool Lime St to Manchester approximately every 10 minutes. The last train departs at 23:36

Trains depart Manchester to Liverpool Lime St approximately every 10 minutes. The last train departs at 23:28

Trains depart Liverpool Central to Ormskirk at 01, 16, 31 and 46 minutes past the hour up until 19:46, the trains then run at 17 and 47 minutes past the hour until the last train at 23:47

A return ticket from Ormskirk-Liverpool-Manchester costs approximately £22

Please be aware there are several Manchester Stations. We reccommend downloading the 'Trainline' app to plan your journey.

Getting to Southport...

By bus:

The nearest bus station to Edge Hill University is located in Ormskirk Town Centre, where you will find several direct bus options to Southport.

The 375 departs Ormskirk from stand 2 at approximately 55 minutes past the hour. The Journey takes 30 mins depending on traffic.

The 385 departs Ormskirk from stand 2 at approximately 22 minutes past the hour. The journey takes 35 mins depending on traffic.

The 152 departs Ormskirk from Stand 3 at 08:23, 10:25, 12:25, 15:25 and 17:47. The journey takes approx 1 hour.

The 375 departs Southport Duke Street (Stop AA) at approximately 05 minutes past the hour until 17:05, buses then depart 50 minutes past the hour. The Last bus departs at 20:50. The Journey takes 30 mins depending on traffic.

The 385 departs Southport Duke Street (Stop AA) at approximately 40 minutes past the hour. The last bus departs at 17:50. The journey takes 35 mins depending on traffic.

The 152 departs Southport Union Street (Stop GB) at 09:30, 11:30, 13:30, 17:15. The journey takes approx 1 hour.

A return ticket from Ormskirk to Southport costs approximately £8

Edge Hill University is a 15 minute walk from the historic market town centre of Ormskirk. Practical information

Buy Travel Insurance

Make sure you have travel insurance that covers healthcare and repatriation. The UK's healthcare system is free at the point of use, but you are likely to be asked to pay after treatment (please note, this has become much more common in recent years).

Bring an adapter

You will need a three pin plug adapter for the UK if travelling from most countries. Ideally these should be as small as possible, as bulky adapters will block others' use of dual plugs (eg in a conference room). Some newer hotels now provide USB plugs for devices. You may also want to bring a portable charging device, as plugs in the conference rooms are limited.

Mobile phone roaming

Check roaming arrangements for your phone in the UK. Whilst Wi-Fi is available on campus (see below) there is very limited free Wi-Fi in public spaces in the UK, and it is not always secure. E-sims may be an option to order before you arrive, if your phone is compatible with the technology.

Packing for British Weather

August is often the UK's warmest and driest month: but it can be wet. You are recommended to bring layers and a waterproof coat. For a more detailed forecast: Ormskirk weather from the BBC

Free Wi-Fi on campus

Eduroam and a guest Wi-Fi option are available free to you when you are on campus. The guest Wi-Fi option will ask you to register (via Sky) before using the service for the first time. These connections are suitable for business use but may struggle with streaming video etc.


