

What is Oxford University Press Journals?

Oxford University Press Journals publish over 230 multi-disciplinary academic and research journals, most in collaboration with learned societies and other international organisations.

How do I access Oxford University Press Journals?

- Like all our electronic resources, Oxford University Press Journals can be accessed via the Library Catalogue.
- Enter 'Oxford University Press Journals' in the search box, choose 'Electronic Library' from the right drop-down menu and click 'search'.
- Connect to the database by clicking on the link in the centre of the screen.

How do I search Oxford University Press Journals?

On the top page you can enter your **search** terms, or click **advanced search** to enter a more complex search or limit your search:

Enter your key words in the **search box**.
