### HOW DO I ACCESS WILEY ONLINE LIBRARY?

- Like all our electronic resources, Wiley online library is accessible via the Library Catalogue.
- Enter 'Wiley online library' in the search box, choose 'Electronic Library' from the right drop-down menu and click on the 'Submit' button.
- Connect to the database by clicking on Wiley online library link in the centre of the screen

### HOW DO I SEARCH WILEY ONLINE LIBRARY?

Click on 'advanced search' as this will allow you to refine your search. You can search the whole database or just a particular discipline

### Executive summary

**Objective** The objective of this systematic review was to report on the best available evidence relating to oral hygiene for adults with dementia in residential aged care facilities, including:

- documenting the prevalence and incidence, as well as the experiences and increments, of oral diseases and conditions
- the use of assessment tools by carers to evaluate oral health
- oral hygiene care strategies to prevent oral diseases and conditions
- the provision of dental treatment and the ongoing management of oral diseases and conditions.

**Inclusion criteria** This review considered any randomised or non-randomised controlled studies, cohort studies, case-control studies, multiple time series studies, uncontrolled studies, descriptive studies and opinions of respected authorities (including these
