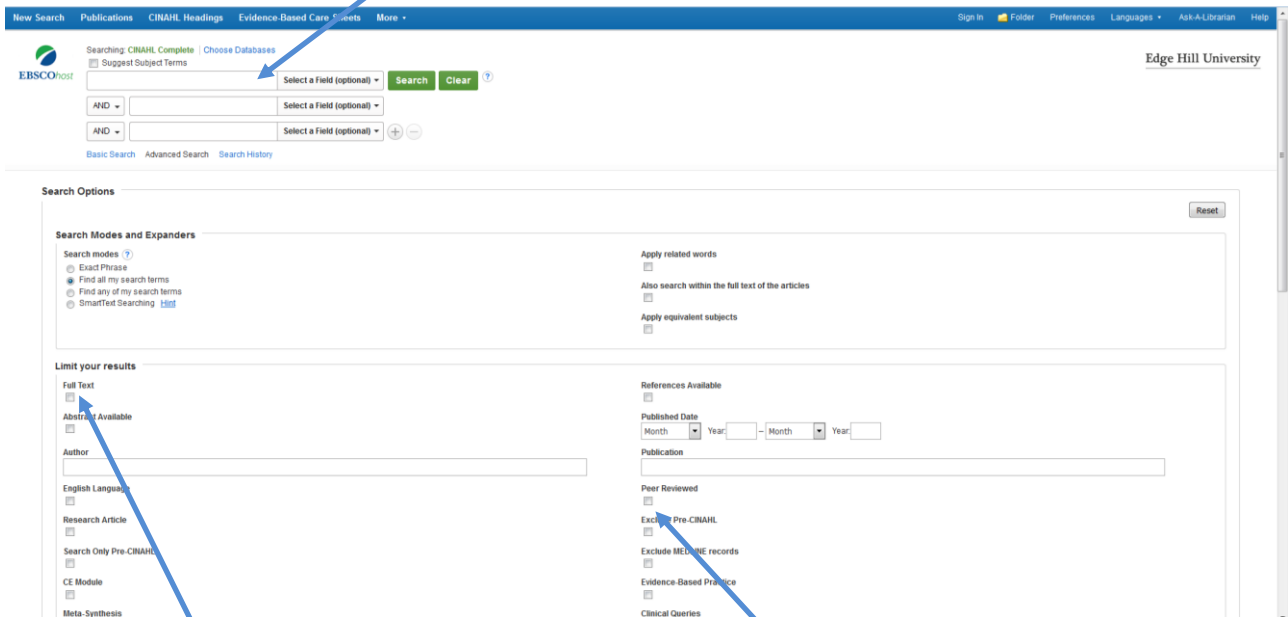
How do I access the Cinahl?

- Like all our electronic resources, Cinahl is accessed through the Library Catalogue.
- Type **Cinahl** in the search box and enter
